SAFETY NOTICE

(1) The Pecan Park HOA board is asking homeowners, residents, visitors and contractors to avoid parking your vehicle directly opposite another car/truck/ trailer on the other side of the street. Please ask visiting contractors to do the same if you see this situation happen. Why......to allow the Jacksonville Fire & Rescue Department (JFRD) Fire Engine Truck access to any home at Lexington Park. JFRD Fire Engine Trucks are large, (30 feet long, 13 feet tall and...9 feet Wide). Cars/Trucks/Trailers parked on the street directly opposite of one another, creates a choke point. Sometimes a Fire Engine Truck is dispatched to respond to a Medical emergency vice responding to a fire. Please pass this onto your guests or family members visiting you. A homeowner had a Medical Emergency and JFRD was blocked from driving up to the address and had to park their Fire Engine on Lexington Park, grab all their gear and run to the victims address to provide assistance. Let's look out for each other. Thanks.
