- **UPDATE**: Governor Desantis signed 2024 Florida Legislature law establishing a 25 foot distance for First Responders, mandating that the public and the media maintain this distance which takes effect on 01 Jan 2025. - **NOTICE**: Our HOA board is <u>asking for homeowner volunteers to serve</u> on the <u>Compliance Committee</u>, whose purpose is to maintain neighborhood property standards to maintain our home values. These members cannot serve on the HOA board but ensure Homeowners are not unfairly scrutinized with unfair reviews or fines.

• HAZARD!: Please do NOT dispose of dead Palm fronds or Yard waste in the Forest Reserve behind homes. This could create a wildfire hazard that could be started by a cigarette butt, lightning strike or other ignition source in our neighborhood. Most homes are only separated by 15 feet. A

minimum wildfire defensible zone is 30-100 feet. Yard waste (& Palm Fronds) are picked up every Thursday).

Beginning on or around August 15, 2024, <u>NHC will begin issuing an experimental version of the Cone Graphic that includes Inland Tropical Storm and Hurricane Watches and Warnings in effect for the continental United States.</u> The Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1 through November 30.

Regularly clear your roof and gutters and prepare your yard by creating and maintaining a defensible space around your home. Last year Florida recorded more than <u>2650 wildfires</u>.
