2024 Florida Senate passed a law establishing a 25 foot distance for First Responders, mandating that the public and the media maintain this distance. This is Florida Senate Bill 184 (Impeding, Threatening, or Harassing First Responders). This has not been signed by Governor DeSantis yet. See LINK https://www.flsenate.gov/session/Bill/2024/184/

UPDATE: Governor Desantis signed into law, Fla Senate Bill 621 Property Rights which protects renters and homeowners from Squatters who squat, damage or try to sell a property. See the March 2024 HOA newsletter. This new law takes effect July 1st this year.

<u>Lexington Park Stormwater Retention Ponds</u>: (<u>This is Florida</u>, <u>always be aware of gators & snakes</u>). We have (5) small Stormwater Retention Ponds in Lexington Park, whose purpose is for <u>Flood control</u>, <u>sediment and nutrient removal and protects downstream water resources like Seaton Creek</u>. The HOA board had a rep from Solitude Lake Management answer questions about Pond monthly maintenance at the HOA board meeting on Thursday, March 28th.

We do not have small natural ponds or large lakes with a natural water supply flushing our pond's standing water. The ponds are "not intended for swimming or boating". ATTENTION: The HOA board asks every homeowner next to a pond, to "Bag their mulch or Mow so the grass clippings discharge AWAY from the pond". Grass clippings discharged into the pond is a major contributor to Algae. The HOA purchased Carp fish to eat Invasive floating weeds, Alligator and Penny weeds. Fishing is not encouraged but ask anyone who fishes to release "our Carp", but some don't, (not good). The pond algae also originates from Potassium and Fungicide lawn treatments that run off from adjoining yards and the road via rainfall. The contractor services the ponds monthly and by state law can only apply so much applicant either by hand or small boat to mitigate floating algae. This treatment does not remove weeds anchored at the bottom of the pond.

We need to maintain our ponds with 4 separate practices, (1) to keep Carp in the ponds who naturally eat weeds, (2) to reduce lawn treatment runoff, (3) to keep grass clippings out of the pond & (4) to continue algae reduction via chemical treatment.
